WHEREAS, the City of Mascoutah recognizes that if it is to be a recipient of federal grants funding, the City of Mascoutah shall comply with a policy of nondiscrimination and shall comply with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and the rules, regulations and executive orders that govern Title VI on federally funded projects; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the City of Mascoutah to have policies and procedures in place to address complaints that may arise under Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964; and

WHEREAS, it is recommended that policies and procedures be followed in order to comply with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Mascoutah, County of St. Clair, State of Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: The City of Mascoutah, Illinois hereby adopts a policy of nondiscrimination and the attached Title VI policy statement ensuring that no person is excluded from participation in or denied the benefits of its services on the basis of race, color, or national origin, as provided by Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964; that a copy of the City of Mascoutah Title VI Policy Statements and Title VI Complaint Form are attached hereto, marked "Exhibit A", and made apart hereof.

SECTION 2: This Resolution shall be in effect following its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.

SECTION 3: Any and all Resolutions, section of subsections of Resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
