The meeting of the Mascoutah City Cemetery Board was opened at 8:35 a.m. on Thursday, November 1, 2018 in the Mascoutah City Hall. Treasurer's Report: The treasurer's report was presented by Treasurer Tom Klingelhoefer for the period August 1, 2018 through October 30, 2018. It was noted that the deposits for the quarter were: \$32.84 was checking account interest, \$808.33 was transfer from City for sale of FY17/18 graves, and \$1,265.53 was interest from CDs. Motion was made by Robert Edwards, seconded by Cathy Klingelhoefer to accept the treasurer's report. Motion passed.

Cathy Klingelhoefer stated that the Historical Society is taking care of the purchase and placement so she will contact Kathy Bell to let her know about using Lager Monument.
