City Manager presented report for Council consideration of approval of an ordinance approving the Final Plat for a re-subdivision of Lot 1 of The Plaza subdivision.

Baker moved, seconded by McMahan, to approve and adopt Ordinance No. 19-09, approving the Final Plat for the re-subdivision of Lot 1 of The Plaza Subdivision, dividing one lot into three standard lots, located on the west side of Illinois Route 4 and east side of Beller Drive.

PC 19-03 – LAKESIDE ESTATES REZONING AND ANNEXATION (SECOND READING)

City Manager presented report for Council consideration of approval of a rezoning application for one parcel (09-36-0-201-036) from Agriculture (AG) to Single-Family Residential (RS-5) and annexation request for one parcel (09-36-0-201-029) with zoning to be designated as Single Family Residential (RS-5). Both parcels are generally located west of McKinley Street and northwest of Eisenhower Street, commonly known as the old Mascoutah Golf Course.

McMahan moved, seconded by Baker, to approve and adopt Ordinance No. 19-10, approving the rezoning request for one parcel (09-36-0-201-036) from Agriculture (AG) to Single Family Residential (RS-5); and approve and adopt Ordinance No. 19-11, approving the annexation request for one parcel (09-36-0-201-029) with zoning to be designated as Single Family Residential (RS-5).
