



## Help Protect Your Drinking Water

Protecting your drinking water supply is everyone's responsibility!

The City of Mascoutah Cross Connection Control Program is designed to safeguard public health by protecting the municipal drinking water supply. **Please complete and return the survey by July 9, 2021.** Your cooperation is essential. If you own more than one property, a separate survey will need to be filled out for each property. Following are a list of the most frequently asked questions.

#### What is a cross Connection?

A cross connection is a physical connection between a possible source of contamination and the public drinking water system piping. This connection, if not properly protected, can lead to the contamination of the drinking water system through a backflow event—or when the flow of water is reversed.

#### What is a backflow preventer?

A backflow preventer is a device that allows the water to flow only in one direction and prevent a pipe or device connected to the water supply line to allow water to flow back into the municipal supply system.

### **Customer Responsibility**

It is the customer's responsibility to ensure that unprotected cross connections are not created. Required backflow prevention devices must be tested to ensure they meet state requirements and must be maintained in operable condition.

### Will anyone contact me after I complete the survey?

If you have or require backflow protection, you may be contacted for compliance testing, repairs, installations, inspections or additional surveys.

### What happens if I do not return the survey?

All water customers are required to complete and return this survey. While there are no penalties or fines for not completing the survey, everyone is encouraged to complete the survey to ensure the City is in compliance with IEPA regulations and can assess the potential risks to our drinking water supply.
