- Knowledge of maintenance and repair of light and heavy equipment such as trucks, loaders, rollers, tractors, excavators, backhoes and mowers.
- Strong knowledge of maintenance and repair of both diesel and gas engines.
- Knowledge of OSHA safety principles and practices.
- Ability to plan, organize and to participate in a variety of semi-skilled and skilled maintenance and repair activities.
- Ability to use tools and equipment properly.
- Ability to follow oral and written instructions.
- Ability to communicate in oral and written form.
- Ability to maintain written records and prepare reports.
- Ability to establish and maintain effective working relationship with department heads and employees.
- Ability to work effectively with the general public.

EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE:

- High school diploma or equivalent.
- One year of related work experience required.
- Experience maintaining heavy equipment preferred.

RESPONSIBILITIES AND DUTIES (other duties may be assigned):

- Performs the duties of a mechanic involved in hands on repairs and maintenance of vehicles.
- Performs regular inspections of vehicles and equipment and notes needed repairs, either accomplishing repair or seeing to it that repairs are made in a timely manner.
- Responsible for the maintenance and repairs to department vehicles, equipment and other City vehicles and equipment.
- Perform road service on equipment as required.
- Adjust or repair hydraulic systems and components.

- Responds to repair requests.
- Operating computer programs and equipment (SCADA).
- Inform Supervisor of inventory of supplies needed for fleet maintenance.
- Maintain files, records and permits.
- Help out different departments when needed.
- Responds to twenty-four hour emergency call situations.

CERTIFICATES, LICENSES, REGISTRATIONS:

- Commercial Drivers Licenses.
- ASE certification preferred.
- Technical training in auto, equipment and diesel mechanics preferred.

PHYSICAL DEMANDS:

- Must to be to drive a vehicle on a daily basis.
- Ability to operate light to heavy equipment and tools.
- Requires prolonged walking, balancing and feeling; occasional climbing, standing, sitting, kneeling, stooping and crouching, pushing and grasping in the performance of daily activities.
- Requires frequent levels of concentration of attention.
- Requires visual and hearing interpretation.
- Must to able to handle over 60 pounds of material occasionally and up to 25 pounds frequently.
- Must be able to move material by hand continuously, by truck frequently and by light and heavy equipment occasionally.
- Should be able to lift and move light weight material for extended distances (>100 yards).
- Must to able to lift 50 pounds from the floor to chest high.

WORK ENVIRONMENT:

- Ability to perform indoor and outdoor duties.
- Hazards include proximity to moving mechanical parts, vibration, electrical current, working on scaffolding and high places, flammable and combustible material, noise, exposure to high heat, exposure to chemicals.
- May be subjected to conditions including fumes, odors, dust, gases, oils or poor ventilation. Worker maybe required to wear a respirator occasionally.
- Ability to perform job duties and responsibilities during emergency stressful situations and under extreme weather conditions.
